



in miljoen euro, 2004






# The use of space has increased dramatically

Between 1900 en 2000...


- ... the number of inhabitants tripled
- ... the average occupancy is halved
- ... the average size of a dwelling has doubled
- ... the space around each dwelling has doubled

Meaning that:


Three times as many Dutch people live with half the number of people per dwelling in houses which are double the size on a plot that has doubled in size

$$3 \times 2 \times 2 \times 2 = 24$$

**A rise in the use of space with a factor 24!**



The global effort for sustainability will be won, or lost, in the world's cities, where urban design may influence over 70 percent of people's Ecological Footprint.



High-Footprint cities can reduce this demand on nature greatly  
with existing technology.

Many of these savings also cut costs and make cities more livable.




Heatmap of apartmentsprices (source DRO)
















Land leased (red) and owned land (yellow)








## Visiekaart Amsterdam 2040
